- It helps develop social skills such as taking turns, sharing, co-operating and negotiating and values such as trust, fairness and respect for others.

In the Nursery we develop this natural curiosity by allowing the children to observe and explore. They experience both natural and man made materials.





































- All staff wear masks.
- Aprons, gloves and masks are changed when dealing with personal care.
- Resources and toys are restricted and washed regularly.
- Arrival and drop off times are staggered.
- Regular handwashing takes place for children and staff.
- Home Learning took place through Seesaw.
